17.07.14	<p>Summarise the Health visitor referral.</p> <p>Health visitor has made a referral. She is concerned that she was unable to complete a 2 year developmental check due to mother’s low mood and lack of motivation. Concerns were also reported regarding poor home conditions, cannabis use and Antony looked neglected and grubby.</p>	Assessment to be completed	SW and HV
17.07.14	<p>Summarise your visit to the home <i>(as a guide imagine you have seen the same conditions as the HV)</i></p> <p>Assessment visit completed. Concerns were evident regarding neglect, low mood and mother using cannabis. Crystal is willing to engage but is very tearful. Antony seen and was only wearing a nappy and was dirty. However a positive bond was observed between mother and child. See Assessment and case notes.</p>	Assessment on going	SW

18.07.14	<p><i>Past files located and read.</i> Summarise past concerns</p> <p>Crystal has been known to CYPs since 01.04.11 due to her mother being concerned about her absconding. Crystal attended housing in March 2011 as homeless but her mother and her resolved issues and the case was closed. Further concerns were highlighted on the 17.09.14 regarding possible grooming and sexual exploitation by an older male. This was assessed and not founded. Crystal has not been known to the department since 21.09.11.</p>	Assessment on going	SW
20.07.14	<p>Summarise a follow up home visit to mother <i>(imagine conditions have remained the same)</i></p> <p>Situation not improved, mother appears unable to make changes and is very low in mood.</p>	Further checks needed	SW
21.07.14	Agency checks made to housing and GP. Rent arrears evident of £700. Last booster for Antony missed.	Assessment completed and decision made to go to ICPC	SW, Housing and GP
01.08.14	ICPC held	Antony made subject of a child protection plan at risk of emotional harm and neglect	SW
